
Staff Training in Schools

Our Family Support School Liaison Service provides training, support and advice to both mainstream and special schools. From early years right through to Secondary we provide information and training around the specific learning profile of children who have Down Syndrome and up to date ideas and strategies to successfully support them.

Observations and follow up reports with recommendations are provided as well as training on various specific issues including how to deal with challenging behaviour and guidance on successful differentiation. A separate list of services for schools provides more detail on all the provision available to schools and school staff and is available on request.

We provide training of any duration at times to suit school teams. Twilights are very popular and can be combined with observations on the same day to give advice tailored to the child and their environment. Schools working together within a cluster can share training opportunities, costs and a chance to exchange ideas.
